February 29, 1984

- An LFA Benefits Trust formed of Members of the Board of Directors to investigate an approximate loss of \$2000.00 of Dental Funds. A report is to be given in two months at which time the BOD will meet to discuss a remedy.

July 18, 1984

- Suspend officer and delegate salary and back debt payments for the month of August to bolster the Contingency Fund in the event of a strike at Saint John's Prep.

August 15, 1984

- Demand to go ahead with arbitration at RVC RE: violation of pension and sick day reimbursement rights under the contract.
- SLRB charge - claiming bad faith bargaining while planning to close two schools. R. Gordon will handle the matter for \$5000.00.

- LFA BOD publicly censure D.Meyer and J. Lanning for:
 - the unauthorized and improper use of LFA heading for personal Campaign Literature which on its face served to deceive the members of BK, BL and Naz. As an official LFA Communication.
 - the Contract of the letter which may have done irreparable harm to the current SJP strike by purporting to be an official LFA Communication.

December 19, 1984

- Candidates for Union Offices will not utilize LFA logo.

1983

February 8, 1983

- To accept Constitution Committee's recommendations for changes to Constitution.

March 24, 1983

- Motion to appoint Mr. Ron Vanchieri to remainder of Treasurer Term when present Treasurer resigns.
- Motion instructed the President to apply \$1600 of the \$3200 in strike reimbursement money owed to us by NYSUT toward the LFA's April obligation to NYSUT.

June 27, 1983

- Table the Bishop Kearney proposed contract until July meeting since some Board of Directors members voiced displeasure and want clarification from BK Representatives and invite the BK Bargaining Team to July's meeting.
- Notice of NYSUT disaffiliation vote to be given during the week of September 19.
- President moved to appoint Paul Kovalesky to finish both terms of HF delegate and LI Vice-President since R. Feeney resigned.

July 29, 1983

- Rockville Centre proposed contract approval.
- Nazareth proposed contract approval.
- Not to renew Robert Gordon's contract. General Council's contract terminated December 1, 1983. Send a letter of appreciation.
- President and Treasurer to be empowered to enter into negotiations with NYSUT in the best interests of the LFA by the October meeting RE: NYSUT debt.

September 15, 1983

- Robert Gordon's contract to be terminated effective December 1, 1983 and not renewed. To send a letter of appreciation to Robert Gordon. The President and the Treasurer be empowered to enter into negotiations with NYSUT in the best interests of the LFA by the October meeting.

October 5, 1983

- A written notice be given and a vote be held to remove the Affiliation Article from the Constitution of the LFA thereby empowering the Board of Directors to disaffiliate the LFA from NUSUT. Notices to be placed in mailboxes tomorrow. AAA voting results will be known by October 20th.
- Empower President to make the best deal with the Linden Towers and to enter into agreement for the office space, as soon as possible, in order to realize a savings of 40% in rental funds.

October 26, 1983

- Monies from the LFA Defense Fund be offered to Charles Cuzzo as compensation for the loss of 1/2 day wages incurred in conjunction with his suspension from Holy Family for union related activities.
- Nazareth proposed settlement accepted.

- RE: New membership campaign, Board decided that for the period October 26 to December 1, any new teacher who joins the LFA will pay dues only from that day forward.

November 30, 1983

- The LFA recommends that the members of the Holy Family School strike the Diocese of RVC for bargaining in bad faith: 318.5 yes, 0 no, and 5 abs.
- President of LFA empowered to select an attorney for the RVC on a case by case basis.
- President to be empowered to secure \$5000.00 Accidental Death Life Ins.

December 12, 1983

- Roger Ramme of Goldstein and Rubinston attorneys at law retained to handle Rockville Centre arbitrations.
- \$7500.00 allocated for preliminary injunction to handle RVC School spin offs. The LFA Defense Fund be established to finance any additional litigations.
- A Committee to be formed to investigate the possibility of using other attorneys for RVC with regard to the Bishop's attempt to close Holy Family HS and Maria Regina HS. Committee is to present to the Board of Directors by January Meeting.

- Herb Magidson to re-do the budget. The Board gave Mr. Magidson until Monday to offer his new plan.
- Abolish the office of Executive Vice-President effective November 30, 1982.
- Retain Mr. Gordan as General Counsel from December 1, 1982 to November 30, 1983. Motion also empowered Executive Vice-President to enter into agreement on behalf of the LFA, that will provide an annual retainer of \$30,000.00 and shall provide that either party must notify the other of its intent to renew or not, on or before August 30, 1983 and that a new agreement must be completed by September 30, 1983
