Dear Members who are covered by the Mason Tenders District Council Welfare Fund:

Please read carefully the attached notice sent from Mason Tenders in December 2018. It is essential to note the change to the eligibility rules for retirement health benefits (Item #3).

Upon further investigation, we were told that there will be a follow up letter from Mason Tenders to extend the window of eligibility through the end of March in order to file for retirement and thus be able to carry one's health benefits into retirement, IF you have been a participant in the plan for the last seven (7) or ten (10) consecutive working years AND are age fifty-five (55) or older.

This means that if you have plans to retire AND wish to continue your Mason Tenders health benefits into retirement, you must file all paperwork by March 31st, 2019. Call LIUNA for a retirement packet IMMEDIATELY (1-800-544-7422). You must attend an information session to assist you in completing the necessary retirement paperwork, which will be on Wednesday, February 6th, 2019 at 4pm at the LFA Office. You should bring the following:

- The LIUNA retirement packet (do NOT fill it out in advance)
- Two (2) blank personal checks
- A copy of your marriage certificate (if applicable)
- Copies of birth certificates for your spouse and any children under age 26 who are still covered by the plan (if applicable)
- Two (2) forms of identification for yourself and your spouse

Spouses are invited to attend this information session and refreshments will be served.

We welcome any and all related inquiries via telephone and email correspondence (see above); however, of late we have been inundated with phone calls and emails about this issue. We ask for your patience and cooperation as we try to respond to each request for information.

Thank you for your attention to this matter and we look forward to seeing you on February 6th at 4pm.
