## **LIUNA PENSION OFFICE CONTACT INFORMATION**

### **FOR RETIREES:**

The LIUNA Pension Office main number is 1-800-544-7422. Current Pensioners (individuals already fully retired) can speak to Sabrina Mattocks about all of their personal information, especially with regards to updating one's address, changing or acquiring a beneficiary card, withholdings, tax statements, and dues deductions.

### **FOR INDIVIDUALS STILL WORKING AND CONTRIBUTING TO THE LIUNA PENSION:**

If a current contributor wants to review his or her personal information such as who is listed as a beneficiary, or to inquire as to the details listed on the annual pension statement, there are different numbers to call dependent upon the first letter of a person's last name:

\*For a last name that begins with the letter **A through D**, call **Darlene at 202-737-1278**.

\*For a last name that begins with the letters **E through K**, call **Carmen at 202-737-1599**.

\*For a last name that begins with the letters **L through Q**, call **Karen at 202-737-2948**.

\*For a last name that begins with the letters **R through Z**, call **Dana at 202-737-2947**.

Checking on the personal information that is on file with the LIUNA Pension Office is crucial for members who are considering retirement in the near future. It is each individual's responsibility to make sure that their contact information, beneficiary designation, and other (post-retirement) items are accurate and up-to-date with the Pension Fund office. Any changes to your contact information should always be directed to the LFA office first and foremost.

In the event of a pensioner's or contributor's passing, one's beneficiary should have been left instructions to contact the LFA office before reaching out to LIUNA or Mason Tenders to file for any benefits to which they might be entitled. The LFA must provide written documentation of a member or retiree's good standing at the time of his or her passing before any benefits request will be fulfilled by either agency.

We encourage all of our membership to call the LFA Office if there are questions about this memo **BEFORE** reaching out to LIUNA.
