## January 15, 1997

## June 11, 1997

- The LFA will recommend affiliation with LIUNA to the entire membership.

- A vote will be taken at both schools on the issue of splitting.

## July 23, 1997

- Pension Expert will be consulted by the BOD.

## September 10, 1997

- The Union will reimburse Lucy O'Flaherty and Kevin Chorusey for expenses incurred due to Bargaining Team Activity.
- Given the vote in favor of same Motion to join LFA to LIUNA made.
- Motion for LFA to join MTDC.
- LFA will organize the Christ the King TACK teachers into the LFA while we uphold LFA's victory at the State Labor Relations Board.

### **October 15, 1997**

- It was suggested that the officers meet with Dan Galinson, Esq. to discuss the lack of progress in certain legal issues.
- The Union will reimburse the Delegate for expenses of printing the contracts for RVC, but will dispute the cost with Kinko's.

### **November 19, 1997**

- The Treasurer is authorized to invest Union funds in any account bearing a higher rate of interest.
- Any non union school employee electing membership in the LIUNA pension or MTDC shall pay the LIUNA dues plus \$10.00 per month for administrators and \$3.00 per month for secretaries.

# 1996

## January 17, 1996

- LFA will extend the funds necessary to secure judgment in the Christ the King case.

## February 28, 1996

- A plaque and \$50.00 will be awarded to a graduating senior at each School and \$700.00 scholarship will be awarded to an underclassmen in each School. The above awards will be granted in 1996.
- BF's Contract is adopted by the BOD.
- St. Edmund's Contract as ratified will be accepted by the BOD.
- The Union will establish a holding Account for the funds raised from St. John the Baptist Christmas Card Sales / donation to the LFA for Scholarship Fund.
